

Executive Nomination Process

Congress 2017

Any student who does not satisfy all of the following parts within their relative section may not be permitted to present their speech, nominate themselves or be elected, as determined by the Executive 2016-2017.

The VicSRC Executive 2016-2017 will be elected at Congress. Students who do not attend Congress may also nominate.

1. Students who do attend Congress – Speech entry

- a. Any student who attends Congress 2017 is eligible to become a candidate. Students need to submit their individual online nomination form by Friday 30th June.
- b. All nominees have the opportunity to have photo taken either during Workshop 1 or after dinner on Day 1 (10th of July).
- c. Nominees have the opportunity to present a 50 second speech to all students attending Congress on Day 2 (11th of July). Nominees will be cut-off by VicSRC returning officer at one-minute.

2. Students who do not attend Congress – Video entry

- a. Students need to submit their individual online nomination form by Friday 30th June.
- b. All nominees should send a suitable photo of themselves to VicSRC via email by Monday 3rd July.
- c. Nominees have the opportunity to prepare a 50 second video which will be shown to all students attending Congress. Length of video must not exceed one minute.
- d. Video nominations must be submitted to VicSRC via email by Friday 30th June.

Speech/video ideas

It is up to nominees what they include in their nomination speeches/videos. Nominees can consider the following questions as they prepare:

- What does student voice mean to you?
- Through your experiences in advocating for change, what is the most important lesson you have learnt?
- How have your attributions to your school's SRC changed your views on student leadership?
- Is there a limit to how much a student can achieve alone?
- Do you think your ability to make a change is hindered because you are a student?
- How do you want to be remembered?
- Who have influenced you, who have you influenced?
- What are you passionate about, why?
- What is your favourite quote? Why?
- Do you think we can all accomplish something every day we are proud of?
